<u>PURPOSE:</u> To assist Gloucester County graduating seniors who are planning to attend college, community college or trade school.

GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS, REQUIREMENTS & INFORMATION:

- Application for this scholarship is open to all seniors that are Gloucester County residents, regardless of race, sex, color, creed or religion.
- One Daffodil Festival Scholarship will be awarded, renewable for up to four years.
- A Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 3.0 must be maintained each year to qualify. Grades and an invoice from the school must be submitted each year.
- The total amount of the Daffodil Festival Scholarship is \$4,000 or \$1,000 per year for four years.
- ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY FRIDAY, JANUARY 30, 2026. A POST MARK DOES NOT QUALIFY.
- Application forms are available in the GHS Guidance Office, Gloucester Parks, Recreation & Tourism Office and the Daffodil Festival Website (www.daffodilfestivalva.org)
- Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of:
 - Contents of Essay
 - o Academic Achievement
 - Community Involvement
 - School Activities/Employment
- All applicants must write a 500-word essay on their short- and long-term goals and how the scholarship will help them achieve those goals.
- Scholarship judges are not from Gloucester County.
- The Daffodil Festival Scholarship recipient will be announced during the Opening Ceremony of the Daffodil Festival, Saturday, March 28, 2026.
- The winner will be notified by phone prior to the Daffodil Festival.
- One letter of reference from a non-family member is required.
- Official High School transcript is required.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD:

- A check will be sent to the college or trade school between June 1st and October 1st.
- Scholarship recipient must supply proof of enrollment each year.
- All checks are made payable to the educational institution.
